Ms. Carbol reminded the committee that TIAA dropped "Cref" from their name and explained that we will be moving forward with the RIA Cap previously discussed and supported by the committee. Ms. Carbol reviewed the Flexible Spending Account rollover for the Healthcare FSA, as well as reminding that each employee must re-enroll in this benefit each year. Ms. Carbol commented that ConnectYourCare gets better with each refill as they begin to remember what each prescription is and you do not have to continue to submit receipts.
